NRHS Membership Report

To: NRHS Board of Directors

This is the membership report for October 1, 2009, the date at which we calculate our year-end comparison numbers. The report has three components.

On-Board Report 9/30/09:

This is the standard monthly On-Board Report. The 9/30/09 is the last report for the 2009 membership year. Future reports will be re-based to track 2010 membership and use the 9/30/09 numbers as the comparison basis.

As of this report, 59 of the 164 chapters have reached renewal rates of 100% or higher compared to their 10/01/08 membership numbers.

NRHS National Membership Trends:

This report shows NRHS national membership numbers and trends annually since 1992 as well as some historical benchmarks for comparison.

2009 membership dropped by over 6% in 2009, a decline similar to the year before. Membership was down in all categories. Some of the drop in At-Large membership was probably a continuing result of the departure of Ontario & Western Chapter, which caused many members to be transferred into the At-large category late in 2008.

Board of Directors Vote Allocations as of 10/01/09:

This report documents the vote allocations for the Board of Directors for the coming year. The formulas and vote assignments are in the NRHS Bylaws, Article VII. The calculation is done one time per year and remains in effect for the following year, adjusted only when chapter charters are approved or withdrawn.

It has been noted that there are a few minor discrepancies between the extract numbers used for this calculation and the On-Board Report. One report is based on a survey of the complete database and the other is updated sequentially, so it is possible for small differences to develop over time. These discrepancies were not material to the allocation of votes except for one chapter, and that chapter was allocated the higher of the two possible vote allocations.

The Board of Directors will have 307 votes in 2010, and the quorum requirement will be 103 votes.

Prior to the 1992 Annual Reports, published membership numbers did not distinguish between Chapter and Associate, or Primary and Family classifications. Pre-1992 breakdowns are from NRHS News Extra. Membership numbers were evaluated on October 31 prior to 1992 and October 1 from 1992 to present. In most years, an insignificant number of renewals are received after October 1. Student membership was not offered before the 2003 membership year. Subscriptions and some organizations are counted in Associate (At-Large) membership numbers for consistency. Some will be reclassified as Organizational at a future date.
