

The Charleston Chapter invites you to join us at the Winter 2010 NRHS Board of Directors Meeting. The board meeting is planned for Saturday and Sunday, January 9 & 10, and the RVP meeting for January 8, 2010 at the Charleston Place Hotel in the heart of the Charleston Historic District. Charleston is served by Amtrak's Silver Meteor and Palmetto Trains as well as most major airlines.

Since its founding in 1670, Charleston has become one of America's most beautifully preserved historic cities. For years, it has ranked among the top 10 destinations in the USA by the top travel magazines. There are dozens of restaurants within six blocks of the hotel that offer everything from five-star dining to fabulous Lowcountry cuisine.

Our hotel is located at the foot of the Old City Market. A stroll through the area offers a historical view of the Old South. Nearby, tours of Fort Sumter, the site of the first shot of the Civil War, the WW II aircraft carrier Yorktown, historic mansions and plantations, are a history buff's delight.

Charleston Place has provided the NRHS a spectacular rate of \$99 per night for advance reservations. The hotel provides high speed internet service in guest rooms, a business center, and a health club with spa, all complimentary. Self parking is available at \$12/day or valet parking at \$25/day.
