SUBJECT: November 2009 Financial Reports

The financial reports for this meeting cover the period Jan. 1, 2009 through Nov. 30, 2009 and use data that has not been audited. These reports exclude many year end accounting adjustments including those for inventory, depreciation, unrealized capital gains, change in value in temporary restricted funds for projects such as RailCamp scholarships, grants, and the library. The reports consist of a comparison of our 2009 Income and Expenses with our budget, a comparison of our Balance Sheet data for this year to date with that for year end values for the preceding seven years.

NRHS is in the process of making some changes to its accounting system and procedures. The most significant one that has been completed to date is to consider unrestricted donations received with dues *current year* income regardless of when the donation has been received. Between Oct. 1 and the end of November 2009, \$12,851 worth of contributory membership donations had been processed, compared to \$4,725 the year before.

The statement of operations report compares our income and expense for this year with the budget as approved by the NRHS Board at its Fall 2008 meeting. All of the income accounts are currently below budget, with the exception of account 4450 RailCamp which was over subscribed and 4800 Unrestricted Donations which includes two very generous bequests that we received last August On the expense side, many of the accounts are now over budget.

The balance sheet (statement of condition) shows that the year end values of our net assets decreased during FY2007 and again during FY2008, but are projected to increase significantly this year. Cash (bank) accounts show a balance of slightly over \$130,000 compared to over \$132,000 at the end of FY2008. We currently have two checking accounts, one at Bank of America which was used for transactions related to just this year's convention and one at Blackhawk State Bank which is used for all other income and expenses. The convention checking account has not yet been closed because a few checks used to pay convention related convention expenses have not cleared the bank.

Typically, the balances in these accounts are kept high enough to cover one month's expenses and as necessary, funds are moved to and from our Merrill Lynch Money Fund
