Status of 2012 NRHS Convention Arrangements As of April 12, 2012

Railroads:

NRHS is working constructively with senior operations management at three Cedar Rapids regional carriers: Iowa Interstate, Iowa Northern and CRANDIC. All are supportive of our train operation plans. Current work is focused on refining operating schedules and cost estimates, firming up insurance and release requirements and planning for transfer of trainset and motive power between carriers.

Railroad managers expect they can support a schedule of announcing specific train operations in June, then finalizing pricing and opening ticket sales by late summer. Exact timing of sales will also depend on switchover of on-line registration system operation from Tacoma 2011 to Cedar Rapids 2012.

NRHS is currently working to assemble a trainset of leased equipment to supplement coaches available locally and to provide premium service. Pricing is being developed for equipment rental. Preferred plan is to operate special train from/to Chicago with Amtrak to move leased cars in and out. Since formal request to Amtrak cannot be submitted until one year before event, we expect that the inbound and outbound trains will be approved, announced and opened for sale on a later schedule than Cedar Rapids-based trains.

NRHS is currently investigating options to provide contract services for train cleaning and on-train catering.

Other Activities:

Old Threshers: Most pricing information has been received and schedules are being finalized.

Industrial tours: Permission has been received from ADM and John Deere, and cost information is available for support services.

Heritage tours: Pricing information received, and schedules being finalized.

Banquet: Pricing received and facility plans in place.
