HOTEL INFORMATION

The conference hotel is the Crowne Plaza Wilmington North, 630 Naamans Road, Claymont, DE 19703. Reservations: Local 302-792-2700 or toll-free 1-800-227-6963. The room rate is \$109.00 for single/double occupancy plus applicable local taxes. Rate includes complimentary hot breakfast buffet, free internet service and hotel parking. When making reservations request "National Railway Historical Society Code NRH" group rate. The Wilmington/Claymont area is served by major airlines at the Philadelphia International Airport (14 miles distant). Amtrak's Wilmington, Del., station is served by Northeast Regional and Acela Express train service; limited complementary shuttle van service from the train station to/from the hotel may be available based on the time of the request. Guests must provide hotel with schedule 72 hours prior to arrival, call 302-792-2700.

FRIDAY TOUR

On Friday, March 30, we will take a deluxe motorcoach from Claymont for a day of railroad and industrial history. Our first stop will be at Kutztown, Pa., where we will board a mixed train on the Allentown & Auburn for a ride on the ex-Reading Kutztown Branch to Topton, Pa. Photo stops will be held during the trip. We will enjoy lunch (included in the ticket price) in the Kutztown station at the conclusion of the ride.

From here, we will proceed to Bethlehem, Pa., for a guided tour of the National Museum of Industrial History, located on the former Bethlehem Steel site. Also here is the Hoover-Mason Trestle which once carried electrified ore jennies past the blast furnaces. The Trestle now has a pedestrian walkway for an up close look at the furnaces and the jennies. We will then return to Claymont where dinner is on your own.
