There was a quorum present in order to conduct business.

General Counsel John Fiorilla, Asst. General Counsel Scott Andes, Asst. Treasurer Carol Ann Cornelius attended in person and Comptroller Bob Heavenrich attended via the phone.

A moment of reflection was given to remember Director Wesley Weis, National Representative Edward Graham and Heritage Grants Chairman Bob Kornreich, all whom passed away since the Spring Conference. They were long time active members of the NRHS and will be truly missed.

Approval of Spring 2019 Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the 2019 Spring Board of Directors' Meeting were approved via email and posted to the admin site on May 18, 2019.

Unfinished Business

Actions of the Executive Committee

The Committee approved the appointment of Robert Ernst as a NRHS Fund Trustee and President.

Bylaws Change

Joe Maloney distributed to the Board prior to the meeting twelve motions (Appendix B) to be presented regarding the Bylaws changes. John Fiorilla reviewed the proposed Bylaws changes with the Board and the thought process of the committee to reach the changes.

Motion #1: Joe Maloney motioned, and Walter Zullig seconded to reduce the size of the Board of Directors to nine (9) members consisting of the President, Vice-President, and seven (7) other members elected by the membership.

Joe clarified that the President and Vice President would have four-year terms with alternating election cycles. All Directors would have two-year terms.

Director Skip Water commented he feels the proposed change to seven Directors is too small. He feels a number between 12 to 15 would be more appropriate.

Director Jon Baake noted that the changes are being done in isolation of a strategic plan.

Comments were taken from the floor both in favor and against the motion as stated. Some felt the smaller Board would not properly represent the membership. Some supported the motion as it will be easier to manage the programs of the Society. General communication was commented as a continuing critical issue between the NRHS, its members and chapters.

Amendment: Skip Waters motioned, and John Goodman seconded to amend the motion to read **11** members, nine Directors, President and Vice President. The amendment passed by a show of hands **14** yes and 6 no.

The motion as amended was passed by voice vote.

Motion #2: Joe Maloney motioned, and Doug Scott seconded to eliminate current requirements for electoral districts and membership apportionment every ten (10) years.

There was a short discussion on how this motion and upcoming motion #3 are similar in concept. It was decided to discuss the next motion before continuing with motion #2.

Skip Waters moved to table discussion of Motion #2. Passed by voice vote.

Motion #3: Joe Maloney motioned, and Tony White seconded to eliminate voting districts, with each member directly voting for the nine (9) Board members, as is currently done with the President and Vice-President.

Joe Maloney discussed the difficult process of creating Districts. With the smaller number of members why not have all members vote directly for all Directors and Officers.

There was discussion from Directors and members on how communication flows to and from the Board with and without Districts.

It was amended by Jon Baake without objection from Joe Maloney to change the wording to "that each member directly votes for the nine (9) Board members, as is currently done with the President and Vice President."

Passed by hand vote.

Jon Baake moved to remove the tabled discussion of Motion #2. Passed by voice vote.

There was discussion on how the NRHS current apportioned the Districts.

Motion #2 was passed by hand vote.

Since Motion #2 and Motion #3 were passed, Motions #4 to #7 will not be required and no action was taken on them.

Motion #8: Joe Maloney motioned, and Jack Hilborn seconded to change the terms of office for the nine Board members, other than the President and Vice-President, from 4 years to two years.

Passed by voice vote.

Motion #9: The Committee moves to reduce the maximum consecutive years of service for Directors from ten (10) years to eight (8) years.

Passed by voice vote.

Motion #10: The Committee moves to reduce the size of the Executive Committee from five (5) members to three (3) members.

The Committee withdraws the motion. No action taken.

Motion #11: Joe Maloney motioned, and Tony White seconded to authorize the Bylaws Committee to draft language to implement the changes that are approved.

Passed by voice vote.

Motion #12: Joe Maloney motioned, and Bob Ernst seconded to authorize the Bylaws Committee to make cosmetic changes to the language of the Bylaws in order to simplify or clarify the language.

Passed by voice vote.

New Business

Midwest Chapter Withdrawal

Bob Ernst motioned, and Wes Ross seconded to withdraw the charter of the Midwest Chapter, NRHS. Passed by voice vote.

Assistant Treasurer

Al Weber motioned, and Walter Zullig seconded to formally appoint Ms. Carol Ann Cornelius as NRHS Assistant Treasurer. Passed by voice vote.

Heritage Grants

Walter Zullig motioned, and Bob Ernst seconded to allocate \$48,000 for Heritage Grants Program awards for 2020 with any shortfall being made up from NRHS unrestricted funds. Passed by voice vote. This amount will be amended to the 2020 NRHS Budget.

Reports

In a change to the meeting structure, most reports were presented at the Advisory Council Meeting. For discussion of the reports see the Advisory Council Meeting Minutes.

President – Al Weber – Al is looking for someone to take over advertising for the NRHS. This would include press releases, articles and print ads.

Treasurer - Bob Bitzer

Treasurer Bob Bitzer reviewed the 2020 NRHS Budget (Appendix C) which was distributed prior to the meeting.

Motion: Bob Bitzer motioned, and Bob Ernst seconded to approve the NRHS Budget as amended for 2020. Passed by voice vote.

Motion: Bob Ernst motioned, and Doug Scott seconded to release the NRHS Financial Reports as submitted. Passed by voice vote.

Electoral Committee – Joe Maloney

Joe urged all to consider running for a position on the Board.

Advisory Council - Del Kittendorf

The Advisory Council met earlier in the day and Del reported the Advisory Council meeting ran long and no business was brought forward.

General Counsel- John Fiorilla

John reported the NRHS did receive money back from the Heber Valley Railroad due to the derailment at the Convention event including the bus rental. The Radisson Hotel Salt Lake City did return about \$4,700 on the hotel charge dispute.



NRHS Fund - Bob Ernst

Bob reviewed the new Trustees who were nominated to the Fund Board.

Motion: Jack Hilborn motioned, and Joe Maloney seconded to approve the appointment of Bob Ernst, Peter Senin, Michael Walker and Victor Varney to the NRHS Fund Board. Passed by voice vote.

Conventions

The Cumberland Convention will be finalized at the Spring 2020 Conference.

Conferences - Bob Bitzer

Bob Bitzer reported the Twin Forks Chapter, NRHS desires to host the 2021 Fall Conference. It would be held in Ronkonkoma, NY on a date in October 2021. The events will include an excursion on the Long Island Rail Road and a banquet.

Motion: Walter Zullig motioned and Doug Scott seconded to approve the Twin Forks Chapter, NRHS proposal for the 2021 Fall Conference. Passed by voice vote.

Bob Bitzer thanked Skip Waters and the members of the North Texas Chapter, NRHS for hosting the NRHS this weekend.

Announcements

General announcements were made.

Adjournment

Motion: Skip Waters motioned to adjourn.

(If motion #3 is approved, then this is not needed)
- 7. (If motion #3 is defeated) Move to require that districts for the chapter members be drawn along boundaries of contiguous states, as currently done for At-Large members. (If motion #3 is approved, then this is not needed)
- 8. Move to change the terms of office for seven Board members, other than the President and Vice-President, from 4 years to two years.
- 9. Move to reduce the maximum consecutive years of service for Directors from ten (10) years to eight (8) years.
- 10. Move to reduce the size of the Executive Committee from five (5) members to three (3) members.

2019 Financial Recap 2020 Proposed NRHS Budget

To the Board of Directors of the National Railway Historical Society To the Board of Trustees of the National Railway Historical Society Fund

Attached is a spreadsheet for the 2020 proposed NRHS Budget and 2019 Recap. It includes unaudited financial data for 2019 through September 30, 2019. We have provided financial projections through December 31st to be used for comparison against the 2020 budget draft. The unaudited financial summary for 2018 has been included as well.

There are seven additional financial documents which are being provided both for the NRHS and the NRHS Fund. These are:

NRHS Balance Sheet
NRHS Budget vs. Actual
Convention results
NRHS Fund Balance Sheet
NRHS Fund Income / Expenses
NRHS Fund Investment Securities
Additional Unaudited Budget Planning Data

The NRHS 2018 Audit Report from RKL, who serve as the auditors for the Society, is currently being completed for review by NRHS and Fund management. RKL will also be completing the IRS 990's for both the NRHS and the Fund.

I would like to thank our Comptroller, Bob Heavenrich, the NRHS Officers and Service Directors for their work in putting the Budget spreadsheet together with both current and prior year data and providing budget recommendations for 2020,

Based on the projections for the remainder of 2019, it is anticipated that we will end up with a positive cash flow to our net income at year end. One of the contributing factors to the Society's cash flow this year was two very large bequests of over \$157,000.00.

The 2020 Budget is a balanced one. It has been developed using conservative management of our financial resources while continuing to provide support and services to our membership, chapters and other individuals and organizations through our educational and grant programs.

The NRHS Fund has established an Investment Committee. A balanced and diversified portfolio has been developed. An unaudited report of the results is attached. The NRHS continues and has expanded its Treasury Bill purchase program. The goals of these investments are to insure that the Society has funding for future preservation and educational programs.

Much of the complex management work of the Society continues to be performed by a small cadre of dedicated volunteers. The Society greatly needs to expand its volunteer work force. The reasons are, first is to assist in the management of costs to operate our non-profit educational organization, and secondly to ensure that there are volunteers being trained to continue to do the work of the Society, both now and in the future.

NRHS

Speaking of volunteers, I would like to recognize our Assistant Treasurer, Carol Ann Cornelius, who did an outstanding and professional job in handling all of the refund processing related to our NRHS Convention Heber Valley Rail Excursion this year. Unfortunately the train derailed in the passenger loading yard and the trip had to be cancelled. This resulted in a complex refund process.

A recap of the budget highlights for 2019 and 2020.....

Income:

- 1. Membership is projected to experience a small decrease for 2020. We have experienced new membership growth due to more aggressive promotion of the Society. Unfortunately some of this has been offset by members passing away or dropping out of the Society.
- The 2019 convention in Salt Lake City, UT did lose money due to the derailment of the Heber Valley trip and refunds being issued. Estimated loss is about \$8724.00. However, our members were asked if they wished to donate their refund to the NRHS Fund and through their generosity over \$15,500.00 were raised.
- 3. The 2020 convention in California is budgeted as a break-even event due to its trip and event structure.
- **4.** We are planning for a robust donation campaign in 2020 using more varied fund raising methods through the NRHS Fund.

Expenses:

- 1. Expense reductions were realized in 2019 with the donation of the NRHS library which had been housed at National Library Relocaters to DeGoyler Library and the closing of our Philadelphia Office at DVARP.
- 2. In 2020 we will continue to issue four printed NRHS Bulletins.
- The 2020 Budget worksheets also provide additional Unaudited Budget Planning Data which includes Temporary Restricted Funds, NRHS Assets owed by the NRHS Fund, and the Litigation Settlement payment.

This budget will be presented at the Board of Director's meeting for discussion and approval at the Fall Conference in Dallas, TX on Saturday, November 9, 2019. Questions can be directed to the Treasurer at treasurer@nrhs.com.
