Over the years we have had little knowledge about how new members learned of the NRHS. That information is critical to best publicizing the existence of the NRHS and to finding new members. In September the process for applying for NRHS membership online was enhanced by asking applicants to "Please tell us how you learned of the NRHS" The online registration form now provides the following check boxes:

Since the revised form went into use in September, we have gained eight new members who indicated they learned of the NRHS through the following. The responses are greater than eight as some checked more than one box.
