I have had a life-long interest in railroads, going back to my childhood hanging out at the South Orange, New Jersey passenger station watching Erie-Lackawanna commuter trains. My family moved to Bowling Green, Kentucky in 1972, so I then became a fan of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad. After graduating from Western Kentucky University in 1981, I moved to Huntsville, Alabama to take a job at the NASA Marshall Space Flight Center, where I've been a computer engineer for over 38 years, supporting numerous projects, including the Space Shuttle, Hubble Space Telescope, International Space Station, and the future Space Launch System. I've been a member of NRHS since 1984, serving as a National Representative from the former North Alabama Chapter for many years under the previous governance system. One of my contributions to NRHS during that time was helping draft the application for the NRHS to participate in the Combined Federal Campaign. Under the current system, I've served on both the Advisory Council the Board of Directors at different times, before the demands of work required me to step back from my NRHS activities. I am also a long-time member of the Rail Passengers Association (formerly National Association of Railroad Passengers).
