Once you get into the site you will be at the opening screen and will have two options.

Choose “Renew your Membership”. You can go back later and make any necessary updates to the information in your account.

If you have never given us your e-mail, or you have changed it, the system will not recognize you and you will not be able to log-in. At that point you have two options, you can either e-mail me at hughrharris@aol.com and give me your e-mail address and tell me that you couldn't log-in, or you can send back the invoice and a check as instructed in the package that we're just sending you.

If you choose Option One above and send me your e-mail address I'll go ahead and enter it into your account and will then e-mail you back to let you know that I've done it and you should be able to get into the account.

We hope that you'll find the new system much more 'user friendly' than the old one.

RailCamp Sponsors – 2018 Deadlines and Guidelines

RailCamp 2018 plans, our 20th year, have begun. No dates have been confirmed yet

by our partners. Dates will be posted on the NRHS website when available. It is never too early to recruit campers with or without specific dates.

RailCamp appreciates all the chapters, groups and individuals who have sponsored campers in the past. Each year more chapters become involved. Priority placement is given to sponsored campers.

To plan ahead, we have only 36 available spots. *We need to know your intention to sponsor by January 15, 2018. The deadline for sponsored applications is March 1, 2018.* No exceptions! By that time applications are arriving and these kids are anxious to hear if they have been accepted. We basically use a first come-first served approach. Applications are recorded as received. Sponsored campers who do not get their applications in by March 1, 2018 fall in line with all the other applicants. They lose their priority placement.

Please understand that there is a very thorough interview process involved with accepting kids into the program. Sponsored candidates are not automatically accepted. This program demands that the campers pay attention, follow directions, and be responsible. Safety is our primary concern. Talking with parents and especially teachers who see these kids away from the family environment gives us good insight as to their ability to be comfortable and function safely within the RailCamp rules. The decision on acceptance is with the RailCamp Committee.

Save the dates of Wednesday, May 30 to Sunday, June 3, 2018 on your calendars for what promises to be a great event.

The St. Louis Chapter NRHS invites the Board of Directors, the Advisory Council and members to attend their Spring 2018 Conference in conjunction with the Railway & Locomotive Historical Society (R&LHS),

who will be holding its 2018 Annual Meeting in St. Louis, Missouri.

The NRHS Registration form will be available in the public section of the NRHS website (<https://admin.nrhs.com>) in the near future.

The R&LHS Annual Meeting and NRHS Conference hotel is the historic St. Louis Union Station Hotel, 1820 Market Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63103. For reservations, please contact the hotel directly, phone 314-231-1234. For the special group rate of \$139 per night, be sure to mention the event name "Railway and Locomotive Historical Society Annual Meeting." Applicable state and local taxes are not included in the stated rate. The St. Louis Union Station Hotel room reservation cut-off date is May 2, 2018.

The St. Louis area is served by major airlines at the St. Louis Lambert International Airport (20 miles distant.) Metrolink light rail service runs every 20 minutes from the airport to the Union Station stop. Fare is \$4.00. Amtrak's downtown station is located approximately five (5) blocks from the Hotel entrance. There is no Hotel shuttle service.

R&LHS is planning several events to take place. Proposed activities include:

- Tour of the John W. Barriger III National Railroad Library at the University of Missouri, St. Louis.
- Visit to the National Museum of Transportation, the nation's premier railroad research library.
- Visit to the Monticello Railway Museum in Monticello, Illinois. A train trip is also planned.
- Train excursion, a circle tour of the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis (TRRA) trackage starting from St. Louis Union Station Hotel.
- Visit to the Union Pacific Railroad Intermodal Facility at Dupou, Illinois.

The R&LHS registration package will include the above as well as three (3) breakfasts and three (3) dinners.

R&LHS is handling all registrations for their Annual Meeting. Please visit their website

(<http://rlhs.org/Meetings/Current/>) for more information. The registration is not yet open as of mid-November.

As an NRHS member, you may register for both R&LHS meeting events and NRHS meetings, or you may register only for the NRHS meetings.

The NRHS meetings are tentatively scheduled for Sunday, June 3, pending final resolution of the rest of the schedule.
