The museum is running short on funds to complete the necessary work — they need over \$500,000.00 — and at this time they do not expect the work to be completed by late 2018.

The convention committee will move ahead with other plans for our Aug. 7-12, 2018 convention, which will still be held in Cumberland, Md. Many other venues are planned for that week. We still plan a visit to Cass, West Virginia, a ride on that railroad, a steam trip at the Everett Railroad and a diesel trip over the Potomac Eagle line.

2018-2019 Convention and Conference Update

This update is summarized from the approved minutes of the *NRHS Board of Directors* meeting, Saturday, October 21, 2017, at the Fall Conference in Kansas City.

Conventions

 2018. Cumberland, MD – The dates for the 2018 Convention are set for August 7 to 12, 2018. The Convention Committee is very close to finalizing the hotel contract. Rail activities are planned each day Wednesday through Saturday of the convention. The Advisory Council and NRHS Board meetings will be held on Thursday. The Annual Membership

- meeting will be held on Friday.
- 2019. Salt Lake City, UT The Convention Committee recently visited Salt Lake City, and looked at hotels. The final hotel selection is not yet finished. To date there is no trip information available from the Union Pacific Railroad. The date at Promontory Summit is May 10, 2019.
- 2020 and Beyond No update.

Conferences

- Fall 2017. Kansas City, MO President Al Weber thanked the Kansas City Chapter for their hospitality.
- Spring 2018 Saint Louis, MO The 2018
 Spring Conference will be held in St.
 Louis, MO in conjunction with the
 R&LHS Annual Meeting. The dates are
 Wednesday, May 30 to Sunday, June 3,
 2018. All events will be arranged by the
 R&LHS. All meetings of the NRHS will
 be held on Sunday, June 3, 2018. Times
 are to be determined. A handout was
 given to the Board and attendees
 outlining the planned events.
- Fall 2018. Scranton, PA The Fall 2018 conference will be in Scranton, hosted by the Lackawanna & Wyoming Valley Chapter. The dates are October 11 13, 2018. This is in conjunction with the chapter's 45th anniversary. Activities are to be determined.
- Spring 2019. Johnson City, TN The George L. Carter Chapter will investigate holding a Conference in Johnson City, TN. Because of the May date for the 2019 Convention this meeting may be held in March or August.
- Fall 2019. Dallas, TX The Fall 2019
 Conference will be November 8-9, 2019
 in Dallas, hosted by the North Texas
 Chapter. Hotel and activities are to be determined.
- 2020 and beyond Bob Bitzer is seeking proposals for future Conferences.

2018 NRHS Election Overview

The NRHS is now soliciting nominations for all Officer and Board positions. The 2018 election is the fourth under the Bylaws previously adopted in 2011.

In this election the President and nine Board positions will be on the ballot. All positions will be four-year terms.

All NRHS members in good standing are eligible to run for any of the Officer and Board positions based on meeting the criteria set forth in the *NRHS Bylaws* Article VII, Section 7. For more details please see the NRHS Bylaws at https://admin.nrhs.com/public. Look for the link to Current Bylaws.

If a member desires to run for office and is qualified based on the criteria in the *NRHS Bylaws* Article VII, Section 7, the member must submit a nomination application to the NRHS Electoral Committee Chair no later than the end of business March 31, 2018. The nomination application is available online at https://admin.nrhs.com.

Once nominations close on March 31, 2018, the Electoral Committee will create the ballot for each of the Districts. The membership mailing of the ballots will commence on or about June 1, 2018.

The election will close on August 1, 2018. All ballots must be postmarked no later than August 1, 2018 to be counted. Election shall be by a plurality of those votes legally cast.

Reminder - 2018 RailCamp Deadlines and Guidelines

RailCamp appreciates all the chapters, groups and individuals who have sponsored campers in the past. Each year more

chapters become involved. Priority placement is given to sponsored campers.

To plan ahead, we have only 36 available spots. We needed to know your intention to sponsor by January 15, 2018.

The deadline for sponsored applications is <u>March 1, 2018</u>. No exceptions! By that time applications are arriving and these kids are anxious to hear if they have been accepted. We basically use a first comefirst served approach. Applications are recorded as received. Sponsored campers who do not get their applications in by March 1, 2018 fall in line with all the other applicants. They lose their priority placement.

Please understand that there is a very thorough interview process involved with accepting kids into the program. Sponsored candidates are not automatically accepted. This program demands that the campers pay attention, follow directions, and be responsible. Safety is our primary concern. Talking with parents and especially teachers who see these kids away from the family environment gives us good insight as to their ability to be comfortable and function safely within the RailCamp rules. The decision on acceptance is with the RailCamp Committee.
